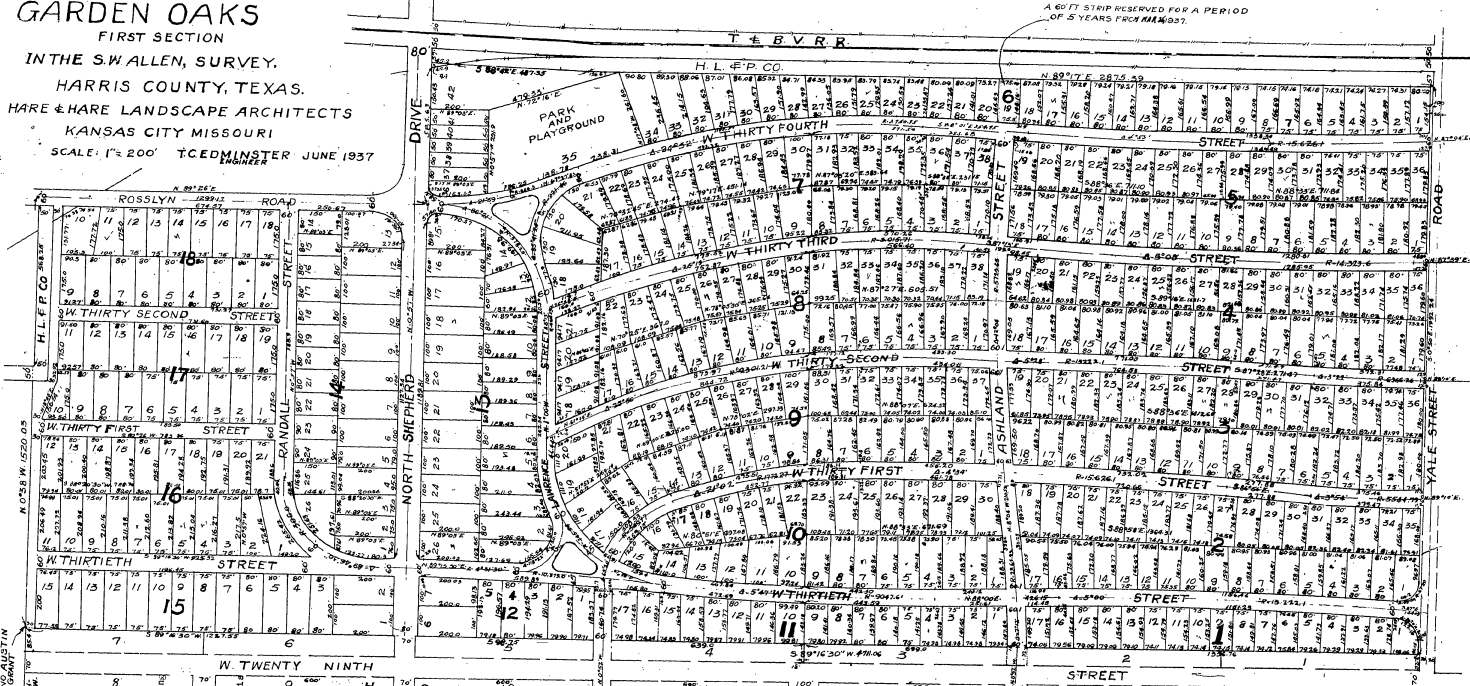


GARDEN OAKS FIRST SECTION
